When completed in 2012, the Shard will stand at 310 m tall and have 72 floors, plus 15 further radiator floors in the roof. It will be Britain's tallest building and the tallest in the European Union.

Unlike many of London's famous towers, the Shard will have a public viewing gallery at the top. Once our work is finished, we're certainly looking forward to taking in the spectacular views over London from the gallery.
